SUBJECT: REVENUE SHARING – Lincoln Theatre Company / Funding to support purchase of audio equipment

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$100 in Revenue Sharing monies to Lincoln Theatre Company for the purchase of new audio equipment to significantly improve the experience for audience members.

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to the Lincoln Theatre Company for new audio equipment. This theatre provides educational opportunities for children and adults focused on performing arts by showcasing local talent and providing quality entertainment through community-based theatrical productions. Their hope in 2016 is to grow their children's program to include workshops and choral concerts. The funds allocated will be used to purchase new audio equipment.
