

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WHEREAS, The Agricultural Commissioner is responsible for preventing the introduction of harmful invasive pests and,

WHEREAS, Placer County is home to a thriving mandarin orange industry and,

WHEREAS, The Asian Citrus Psyllid is a harmful invasive pest that is responsible for vectoring the citrus greening disease that is 100% fatal to citrus trees and,

WHEREAS, The Asian Citrus Psyllid has been rapidly spreading throughout southern and Central California and,

WHEREAS, The California Department of Food and Agriculture proposes to contract with Placer County for the purpose of offsetting the costs of conducting a trapping program to detect the presence of the Asian Citrus Psyllid,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT: The Board of Supervisors authorizes and directs the Agricultural Commissioner to sign State contract #15-0555-SF in the amount of \$72,209 with the California, Department of Food and Agriculture, for reimbursement for Asian Citrus Psyllid detection trapping.
