BACKGROUND

The purpose of the Squaw Valley Municipal Advisory Council is to advise the Board of Supervisors on matters specifically referred to it by the Board of Supervisors for review and recommendation, and on matters of concern which relate to the area served by the Council. The Council shall adopt rules, regulations and procedures as are reasonable and appropriate for its activity, and as are specifically approved by the Board of Supervisors. The council is composed of nine members at-large appointed by the Board of Supervisors, each member serving two-year terms. Members shall, at the time of appointment and at all times during term of office, be residents, property owners of real property, or business owners or managers operating a business within the Council boundaries. Failure to maintain such status shall result in a vacancy of office. The council meets on the first Thursday of each month at 6:00 p.m. at the Squaw Valley Public Service District, Community Meeting Room.
