SUBJECT: Engineering / Permission to Advertise / Christmas Tree Bus Shelter

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the project plans and specifications for the Christmas Tree Bus Shelter and authorize the Department to advertise for bids.

BACKGROUND

The Christmas Tree Bus Shelter is will be located on the south side of Highway 28, midway between Coon Street to the west and Fox Street to the east in Kings Beach.

Approved as part of the Kings Beach Commercial Core Improvement Project (KBCCIP), this site was to receive an existing shelter relocated from Coon Street. The contractor found the existing structure to be compromised and it was discarded.

The new shelter will be built on the footprint that was specified for a shelter in the KBCCIP. The new shelter will be an improvement to provide protection from weather for patrons waiting for the bus. The improvements will use the new bus turnout and sidewalk that were constructed as part of the KBCCIP.

ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE

This project is categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA under the following sections: Section 15301, Existing Facilities, Class 1; Section 15303, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures Class 3.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total project cost is estimated to be \$60,000 with construction costs estimated at \$47,000. This project is budgeted in the FY 2016-17 Department of Public Works and Facilities Final Budget, Bus Stop Improvements (PC2822), and is funded through county transient occupancy taxes and a grant from the Placer County Air Pollution Control District.
