SUBJECT: Contracts for Mental Health Services Act Services

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve five contracts extending services as a result of RFP No. 10351 to provide MHSA services from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$2,411,006 (no net County cost), and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the agreements and subsequent amendments up to a total of 10 percent of each contract amount, consistent with the current agreements' subject matter and scope of work. The contracts will be with KidsFirst, Latino Leadership Council, Lighthouse Counseling and Family Resource Center, Native Alliance of the Sierra Nevada Foothills, and Whole Person Learning.

BACKGROUND

In 2004, California voters passed Proposition 63, the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) establishing a county and community partnership to provide mental health services to those challenged with mental health issues and address the mental health needs of underserved populations. From its first implementation in 2006, MHSA has effectively delivered community supports and intensive crisis services, housing and ongoing supports to the seriously mentally ill, and a host of well-researched, evidence-based prevention and early intervention programs, all without local county dollars.

The County's Campaign for Community Wellness, which functions as the County's required MHSA Steering and Approval committee and includes service recipients, community-based providers from many sectors, and various county agencies, has overseen and reviewed the progress of these contracts.

Descriptions of the services and dollar amounts recommended for award to each contractor are detailed in Attachment 1.

FISCAL IMPACT

Total expenditures under these five contracts, \$2,411,006, are included in the Department's FY 2016-17 Proposed Budget:
