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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve appropriation of \$250 in Revenue Sharing monies to Placer People of Faith Together *Growing Peace Camp* to support youth programs and activities as requested by Supervisor Holmes.

**BACKGROUND**

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support The Placer People of Faith Together which has been operating in the Auburn area for over 28 years as a grass-roots community-based program. The program provides an alternative day camp experience for children age 5 to 11, and a counselor-in-training program for teens age 13 to 17 from diverse ethnic, economic and cultural backgrounds, including those who may be at risk or low income. Through the use of art, music, food tasting, games and discussions, campers learn how to respect each other and develop non-violent peaceful skills to live together. Funding received this year will be used to for operational activities of the camp: supplies, printing, promotional materials, training and background screening for volunteers and staff.
