**SUBJECT:** State funding for County GWSS Program, formerly known as Pierce's Disease Enforcement Program July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2018.

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### **ACTION REQUESTED**

Adopt a resolution authorizing the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer to sign contract #16-0423-SF in the amount of \$100,018 with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for reimbursement for County GWSS Program, formerly known as Pierce's Disease Enforcement Program for FY 2016-17 and 2017-18.

### **BACKGROUND**

The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) provides for reimbursement for various programs under the direction of the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures to help offset the costs to counties for enforcing mandated programs.

Under this contract, the County will be reimbursed up to a maximum of \$50,009 each fiscal year for participating in the State's Glassy-Winged Sharpshooter program for prevention and/or control of this insect pest, which transmits Pierce's Disease to grapevines. The State first began contracting with Placer County for this program during the 1999 – 2000 fiscal years.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL**

This activity does not qualify as a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

This revenue reimbursement is for an ongoing program and has no impact on the General Fund.
