ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$1,000 in Revenue Sharing monies to Placer Land Trust as requested by Supervisor Weygandt (\$500) and Supervisor Holmes (\$500).

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support the protection of the natural wonders and habitats of the community. Placer Land Trust was formed during a time when growth in Placer County was booming. This organization has protected over 8,000 acres including: natural areas, family farms, wildlife habitats, working ranches, river and canyon lands, public parks, trails and trailheads. They actively manage properties that they own and through careful financial planning see that sufficient funds and endowments will enable lands to be forever stewarded. The funds granted to this request will be used to support the objectives listed above.
