SUBJECT: Funding agreement with the Town of Truckee for operation of the Donner Summit Winter Shuttle.

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve an agreement between Placer County and the Town of Truckee (Town) for operation of the Donner Summit Winter Shuttle for FY 2016-17, at a budgeted net County cost of \$29,000.

BACKGROUND

Placer County has partnered with the Town for several years to provide transit service between Truckee and Donner Summit during the winter months. Staff recommends approval of the Funding Agreement between Placer County and the Town regarding operation of the Donner Summit Winter Shuttle. This year's winter service will operate December 16, 2016 through March 12, 2017 and will include several stops between Truckee and Donner Summit.

As outlined in the agreement, the Town will oversee the day-to-day management and operation of the Donner Summit Winter Shuttle including marketing and advertising, shuttle maintenance and management oversight. The Funding Agreement is a public-private partnership and includes participation from the Town, Sugar Bowl Corporation and Boreal Ridge Corporation for a total annual service cost of \$111,102. This agreement includes Placer County's share of \$29,000.

The North Lake Tahoe Resort Association's Infrastructure Committee and Board of Directors have voted to recommend this program for approval by your board. The agreement is funded with general fund Transient Occupancy Tax dollars.

FISCAL IMPACT

Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) collected in eastern Placer County is the funding source for services to be provided by this agreement. These funds were budgeted for in the final approved FY 2016-17 Lake Tahoe Tourism and Promotion budget in the amount of \$29,000 and were specified for this purpose.

**AN AGREEMENT TO FUND AND OPERATE THE "DONNER SUMMIT
WINTER SHUTTLE" BETWEEN THE TOWN OF TRUCKEE AND THE
COUNTY OF PLACER, BOREAL RIDGE CORPORATION, AND SUGAR
BOWL CORPORATION**

This Agreement is made the 27th day of September 2016, by and between the Town of Truckee, a municipal corporation of the State of California ("TOWN") and County of Placer, a political subdivision of the State of California; Boreal Ridge Corporation, a California corporation; Sugar Bowl Corporation, a California corporation; (collectively, but not including the TOWN, "PARTIES").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the TOWN and PARTIES desire to fund and operate the Donner Summit Winter Shuttle, hereinafter referred to as the SHUTTLE, to transport people daily between the Town of Truckee and Donner Summit ski resorts during the winter season, and;

WHEREAS the TOWN and PARTIES have the funds available to provide the desired service;

NOW, THEREFORE, and in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, it is agreed by and between the TOWN and PARTIES as follows:

1. The TOWN shall provide a turn-key transit operation for the SHUTTLE, including all services and materials necessary to operate the service. Said services and materials shall include but not be limited to provision of all operations personnel, suitable vehicles, fuel, maintenance, and administrative support, all to ensure a safe and reliable level of service. TOWN shall require all drivers to have and maintain either a California or Nevada commercial driver's license of the class required to drive passenger transportation vehicles.
2. The TOWN reserves the option of entering into a contract with a private transit operator for the operation of the SHUTTLE. If the TOWN contracts for this service, it shall monitor and oversee such provider on behalf of the PARTIES, and shall remain fully responsible for the implementation of these terms of this Agreement through the selected provider.
3. Subject to its rights under Section 4 herein, the TOWN shall operate the SHUTTLE from December 15, 2016 through March 12, 2017, an eighty-eight (88) day operating period, and during the hours shown in Exhibit 1, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The SHUTTLE shall stop to board and unload passengers at any point, where in the driver's assessment it is safe to do so, between the starting point in Truckee and the terminus on Donner Summit.

The total estimated cost to operate the SHUTTLE is \$111,102, and includes contracted service hours (\$70,869), fuel and maintenance (\$31,878), marketing of the service (\$2,850), and management oversight (\$5,505). The PARTIES and TOWN shall fund the SHUTTLE service as set forth below. The actual amounts paid by the PARTIES and TOWN are subject to adjustment pursuant to Section 5 herein.

4. The TOWN's obligation to provide the service described in this Agreement is subject to weather and traffic delays. In the event of deteriorating weather or any condition(s) that makes continuation of the service marginally safe or unsafe to conduct, the PARTIES agree that service shall be suspended. The determination of whether the SHUTTLE shall continue operations in deteriorating weather shall rest solely with the TOWN or its designated agent.

5. The PARTIES and TOWN each agree to pay for the cost of the SHUTTLE service in the following amounts and percentages of the estimated total cost of the SHUTTLE service, subject to adjustment as provided below:

Sugar Bowl Corporation	<u>\$ 26,551 (23.90%)</u>

The PARTIES may pay their respective contributions in four equal installments with the first installment due no later than December 1, 2016 and the last installment due no later than May 1, 2017. TOWN shall provide Boreal Ridge Corporation and Sugar Bowl Corporation with a final invoice that reflects the total farebox received at the Donner Pass Road/Sugar Bowl Road and Ski Inn bus stops. The total farebox received at these two bus stop locations shall be split equally between Boreal Ridge Corporation and Sugar Bowl Corporation, and applied to the final invoices.

6. Employees of Boreal Ridge Corporation and Sugar Bowl Corporation shall be entitled to ride the SHUTTLE free of charge upon displaying a valid employee identification card, provided that such employees shall not have priority for space on the SHUTTLE over other passengers.

7. The PARTIES are funding agents only, and specifically, are not held responsible for any operational aspect of the project, including operation of the transit vehicle, provision of maintenance, insurance coverage, or any costs in excess of the financial contributions to the total cost of the service as set forth above, nor shall they have any liability for equipment or personnel not under their control.

8. The TOWN shall indemnify and hold harmless each of the other PARTIES, their agents, officers, and employees, against liability for injury or death to persons, or damage to property, caused by any act or omission of it, or its agents, officers or employees, or subcontractors, arising out of the performance of this contract by TOWN. This indemnity shall not extend to any liability arising from the acts or omissions of the PARTIES.

9. The PARTIES shall each advertise and disseminate information about the SHUTTLE. Advertising by each PARTY is a separate responsibility from the PARTIES' payment obligations set forth herein, and such payment obligations shall not be reduced or offset by the costs of advertising and promotion of the SHUTTLE.

10. In the event of a default caused by non-payment as required in this Agreement, the TOWN shall notify all PARTIES to this Agreement of the default, and ask the defaulting party in writing that such default be cured within ten (10) business days of receipt of such notification. The defaulting PARTY shall remain fully liable for all costs and payments agreed to in this Agreement. The default of one PARTY shall not be grounds to terminate this Agreement except upon the mutual agreement of all of the remaining PARTIES to the Agreement.

12. This Agreement represents the entire agreement of the PARTIES and the TOWN with regard to the subject matter it contains and supersedes all previous oral or written agreements or representations between the PARTIES and the TOWN in that regard.

This Agreement may be amended or modified only by a written instrument executed by authorized signatories of the TOWN and all PARTIES.

13. This Agreement shall be interpreted in accordance with California law, provided however that it shall be construed as if jointly prepared by the PARTIES and the TOWN and no presumption shall arise from the identity of the drafter. Any action to interpret or enforce this Agreement shall be brought and maintained exclusively in the courts of and for Nevada County, California.

14. Each of the PARTIES and the TOWN represents and warrants that it has the requisite power and authority to enter into, and perform its obligations under, this Agreement, and that the person executing this Agreement on the TOWN's and each respective PARTY's behalf is authorized to do so.

15. In operating the SHUTTLE, TOWN shall comply, and shall require its drivers to comply, as applicable, with the requirements of the following: (i) 49 CFR Part 655 ("Prevention of Alcohol Misuse and Prohibited Drug Use in Transit Operations"); (ii) 49 CFR Part 382 ("Controlled Substances and Alcohol Use and Testing"); (iii) 49 CFR Part 40 ("Procedures for Transportation Workplace Drug Testing Programs"); (iv) 49 CFR Part 37 ("Transportation Services for Individuals with Disabilities"); (v) 49 CFR Part 38 ("Americans with Disabilities Act [ADA] Accessibility Specifications for Transportation Vehicles"); and (vi) 49 CFR Part 395 ("Hours of Service of Drivers").

16. TOWN shall provide, or shall require its contract transit operator to provide, insurance meeting the following requirements, provided that notwithstanding any term herein to the contrary TOWN may satisfy its obligations under sections 16.2 and 16.4 below by providing coverage through CalTIP:

16.1 WORKER'S COMPENSATION AND EMPLOYERS LIABILITY INSURANCE:

Worker's Compensation Insurance shall be provided as required by any applicable law or regulation. Employer's liability insurance shall be provided in amounts not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) each accident for bodily injury by accident, one million dollars (\$1,000,000) policy limit for bodily injury by disease, and one million dollars (\$1,000,000) each employee for bodily injury by disease. If there is an exposure of injury to TOWN's employees under the U.S. Longshoremen's and Harbor Worker's Compensation Act, the Jones Act, or under laws, regulations, or statutes applicable to maritime employees, coverage shall be included for such injuries or claims.

Each Worker's Compensation policy shall be endorsed with the following specific language:

Cancellation Notice - This policy shall not be changed without first giving thirty (30) days prior written notice and ten (10) days prior written notice of cancellation for non-payment of premium to the County of Placer.

Waiver of Subrogation - The workers' compensation policy shall be endorsed to state that the workers' compensation carrier waives its right of subrogation against the County, its officers, directors, officials, employees, agents or

volunteers, which might arise by reason of payment under such policy in connection with performance under this agreement by TOWN.

TOWN shall require all subcontractors to maintain adequate Workers' Compensation insurance. Certificates of Workers' Compensation shall be filed forthwith with the County upon demand.

16.2 GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE:

A. Comprehensive General Liability or Commercial General Liability insurance covering all operations by or on behalf of TOWN, providing insurance for bodily injury liability and property damage liability for the limits of liability indicated below and including coverage for Contractual liability insuring the obligations assumed by TOWN in this Agreement.

B. One of the following forms is required:

- (1) Comprehensive General Liability;
- (2) Commercial General Liability (Occurrence); or
- (3) Commercial General Liability (Claims Made).

C. If TOWN carries a Comprehensive General Liability policy, the limits of liability shall not be less than a Combined Single Limit for bodily injury, property damage, and Personal Injury Liability of:

- One million dollars (\$1,000,000) each occurrence
- Two million dollars (\$2,000,000) aggregate

D. If TOWN carries a Commercial General Liability (Occurrence) policy:

(1) The limits of liability shall not be less than:

- One million dollars (\$1,000,000) each occurrence (combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage)
- One million dollars (\$1,000,000) for Products-Completed Operations
- Two million dollars (\$2,000,000) General Aggregate

(2) If the policy does not have an endorsement providing that the General Aggregate Limit applies separately, or if defense costs are included in the aggregate limits, then the required aggregate limits shall be two million dollars (\$2,000,000).

E. Special Claims Made Policy Form Provisions:

TOWN shall not provide a Commercial General Liability (Claims Made) policy without the express prior written consent of COUNTY, which consent, if given, shall be subject to the following conditions:

(1) The limits of liability shall not be less than:

- One million dollars (\$1,000,000) each occurrence (combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage)
- One million dollars (\$1,000,000) aggregate for Products Completed Operations
- Two million dollars (\$2,000,000) General Aggregate

(2) The insurance coverage provided by TOWN shall contain language providing coverage up to one (1) year following the completion of the contract in order to provide insurance coverage for the hold harmless provisions herein if the policy is a claims-made policy.

Conformity of Coverages - If more than one policy is used to meet the required coverages, such as a separate umbrella policy, such policies shall be consistent with all other applicable policies used to meet these minimum requirements. For example, all policies shall be Occurrence Liability policies or all shall be Claims Made Liability policies, if approved by the County as noted above. In no cases shall the types of policies be different.

16.3 ENDORSEMENTS

Each Comprehensive or Commercial General Liability policy shall be endorsed to provide that each of the PARTIES is an additional insured with respect to all liability arising out of the operations by or on behalf of Town, and shall also be endorsed with the following specific language:

A. The County of Placer, its officers, agents, employees, and volunteers are to be covered as an additional insured for all liability arising out of the operations by or on behalf of the named insured in the performance of this Agreement.

B. The insurance provided by the Consultant, including any excess liability or umbrella form coverage, is primary coverage to the County of Placer with respect to any insurance or self-insurance programs maintained by the County of Placer and no insurance held or owned by the County of Placer shall be called upon to contribute to a loss.

C. This policy shall not be changed without first giving thirty (30) days prior written notice and ten (10) days prior written notice of cancellation for non-payment of premium to the County of Placer.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the event that TOWN provides self-insurance through CalTIP, TOWN shall not be required to provide an additional insured endorsement to Placer County, since Placer County is already insured through CalTIP.

16.4 AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY INSURANCE:

Automobile Liability insurance covering bodily injury and property damage in an amount no less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) combined single limit for each occurrence.

Covered vehicles shall include owned, non-owned, and hired automobiles/trucks.

16.5 ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

Premium Payments - The insurance companies shall have no recourse against the COUNTY and funding agencies, its officers and employees or any of them for payment of any premiums or assessments under any policy issued by a mutual insurance company.

Policy Deductibles - TOWN shall be responsible for all deductibles in all of TOWN's insurance policies. The maximum amount of allowable deductible for insurance coverage required herein shall be \$25,000, provided that this shall not be construed to apply to any self-insured retentions existing under TOWN's coverage through CalTIP in the event that TOWN opts to satisfy its insurance obligations hereunder through CalTIP.

TOWN's Obligations - TOWN's indemnity and other obligations shall not be limited by the foregoing insurance requirements and shall survive the expiration of this agreement.

Verification of Coverage - TOWN shall furnish the County with original certificates and amendatory endorsements or copies of the applicable policy language effecting coverage required by this clause. All certificates and endorsements are to be received and approved by the County before work commences. However, failure to obtain the required documents prior to the work beginning shall not waive TOWN's obligation to provide them. The County reserves the right to require complete, certified copies of all required insurance policies, including endorsements required by these specifications, at any time. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no certificate or other evidence of coverage beyond evidence of CalTIP membership shall be required for any coverage obtained by TOWN through CalTIP.

Material Breach - Failure of TOWN to maintain the insurance required by this agreement, or to comply with any of the requirements of this section, shall constitute a material breach of the entire agreement.
