SUBJECT: Authorize the Chief Probation Officer to execute an MOU for services at the Juvenile Detention Facility with the Placer County Office of Education

---

**ACTION REQUESTED:**

1. Authorize the Chief Probation Officer to sign a non-monetary Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Placer County Office of Education (PCOE) for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019, for educational services provided by PCOE in the Juvenile Detention Facility (JDF), and any amendments, consistent with the MOU's subject matter and scope of work.

**BACKGROUND:**

Probation desires to ensure that educational services are provided to youth in detention in compliance with Title 15: Minimum Standard for Local Juvenile Facilities and in compliance with Compulsory Education Section 48200 of the Education Code and the Federal IDEA Regulations.

Placer County Office of Education desires to provide for the administration and operations of a juvenile court school as established per Education Code Section 48645.2.

The purpose of this agreement is to jointly continue the Honour Schaps School, a court school for at-risk youth in Placer County. The objective of the joint partnership between PCOE and Probation is to provide comprehensive education services to the at-risk youth detained in the Placer County Juvenile Detention Facility.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

There is no cost associated with this agreement.
