SUBJECT: **Engineering / Professional Services Agreement Amendment No. 3 / Sycamore Environmental Consultants, Inc. / Crosby Herold Bridge at Doty Ravine**

ACTION REQUESTED

Adopt a Resolution to approve Amendment No. 3 to Professional Services Agreement No. 1174 with Sycamore Environmental Consultants, Inc. for environmental support services for the Crosby Herold Road at Doty Ravine Bridge Replacement Project, for an additional amount of \$11,249, increasing the total agreement amount not to exceed to \$162,192 and authorize the Director of Public Works and Facilities, or designee, to execute future contract amendments up to an additional amount of \$16,219.

BACKGROUND

On October 7, 2014 the Board of Supervisors approved PSA No. 1174 with Sycamore Environmental Consultants, Inc. for environmental support services for the Bridge Replacement Project on Crosby Herold Road at Doty Ravine. On October 18, 2014, Amendment No. 1 in the amount of \$1,500 was approved internally to include consultation services with Native American interests. On May 3, 2016, Amendment No. 2 in the amount of \$5,501.91 was approved internally to update consultant rates.

Initial work on Task 6, Extended Phase 1 Investigations, were completed and archeological discoveries were made. Caltrans is requiring additional field work to complete the Extended Phase 1 work. This amendment will allow for the archeological review to be completed and the project to move forward into CEQA and NEPA review. In order for this to be accomplished, the consultant's budget must be increased to complete Task 6.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

The Professional Services Agreement is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15301c.

FISCAL IMPACT

Contract Amendment No. 3 would increase the not to exceed amount by \$11,249. The total contract is for an amount not to exceed \$162,192. This project is fully funded through a combination of Highway Bridge Program funds. There are sufficient funds available in the FY 2016-17 proposed budget, Crosby Herold Road at Doty Ravine Bridge Replacement Project, PC2972.


WHEREAS, the existing bridge on Brewer Road over Doty Ravine has been determined to be functionally obsolete and structurally deficient, and

WHEREAS, environmental review was begun by Sycamore Environmental Consultants, Inc.; and


WHEREAS, proceeding with the environmental review requires additional archeological field investigations; and
