

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that bids are being solicited by the County of Placer (the "County") to furnish all labor, material, tax, and services necessary for the **PLACER COUNTY APLEGATE REGIONAL SEWER PIPELINE PROJECT, PROJECT NO. 40226**.

The Work consists generally of the following: Furnish all labor, materials, equipment and incidentals required to construct approximately 20,770 lineal feet of 10-inch pipeline, 2,800 lineal feet of 8-inch pipeline, 4,850 lineal feet of 10-inch pipeline, and one pump station in its entirety as shown on the Drawings and Specifications.

The County has estimated the cost of the Work to be **Six Million, Nine Hundred Fifty Three Thousand, Seven Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$6,953,760.00)**.

Bids must be received by the County at the Office of Procurement Services, 2964 Richardson Drive, Auburn, CA 95603, on or before **3:30:00 p.m., Thursday, March 1, 2012**.

Official copies of the Contract Documents for bidding may only be obtained from the Office of Procurement Services, 2964 Richardson Drive, Auburn CA 95603, (530) 889-7776, upon payment of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00). Alternatively, these documents may be obtained from said office by mail upon request and payment of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00). Bid documents may be purchased in person at Procurement Services, or can be ordered online at www.placer.ca.gov/admin/procurement/openconstructionbids.aspx. The payment is non-refundable.

A pre-bid conference for informational purposes will be held on **Thursday, February 9, 2012, at 9:00 AM at the County offices of the Community Development Resource Agency, Planning Commission Hearing Room, 3091 County Center Drive (corner of Bell Road and Richardson Drive), Auburn, CA 95603**.

The successful bidder must possess at all times a valid Class A Engineering Contractor's License issued by the State of California and the Well Drilling Contractor must possess a C-57 license issued by the State of California's Contractor License Board.

The Work is subject to the payment of prevailing wages under Labor Code section 1770 et seq. Copies of the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the rates for overtime and holiday work in the locality in which the work is to be performed for each craft, classification or type of worker needed to perform the Work are on file with the County and are available upon request.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code section 22300, the successful bidder may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the County to insure performance of the Work.

Protests to the award of the Contract are subject to the provisions of Section 10.0 of the Placer County Purchasing Policy Manual, which is available upon request.
