

## **NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that bids are being solicited by the County of Placer (the "County") to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, tools, tax, and services necessary for the PLACER COUNTY LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE SERVICES DOUGLAS BOULEVARD CONTRACT Bid No. 10149.

The Work consists generally of the following: Provision of all landscape and grounds keeping functions, operations and techniques to properly care for and maintain landscaping located along the north side of Douglas Boulevard, in the median of Douglas Boulevard, and in other locations in Granite Bay, California as specified herein.

Bids must be received by the County at the Office of Procurement Services, 2964 Richardson Drive, Auburn, CA 95603, (530) 889-7776 by 3:30:00 p.m. on THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 2012. Bids will be opened immediately after 3:30:00 p.m. on said date.

A pre-bid conference for informational purposes will be held on FRIDAY, JANUARY 20, 2012, at 9:00 AM at Granite Bay Community Park at 6475 Douglas Boulevard, in Granite Bay, CA. Bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid conference. For the purposes of bidding on the Contract, bidders will be considered to be on notice of any and all information discussed at said conference regardless of attendance.

The successful bidder must possess at all times a valid C27 Landscaping Contractor's License and a valid Qualified Applicator Certificate issued by the State of California.

The Work is subject to the payment of prevailing wages under Labor Code section 1770 et seq. Copies of the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the rates for overtime and holiday work in the locality in which the work is to be performed for each craft, classification or type of worker needed to perform the Work are on file with the County and are available upon request.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code section 22300, the successful bidder may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the County to insure performance of the Work.

Protests to the award of the Contract are subject to the provisions of Section 10.0 of the Placer County Purchasing Policy Manual, which is available upon request.
