**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF RULE 502  
NEW SOURCE REVIEW**

Placer County Air Pollution Control District amended Rule 502, NEW SOURCE REVIEW on October 13, 2011. Upon review by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the rule received limited approval for incorporation into the California State Implementation Plan. EPA noted a few deficiencies and the Rule received limited disapproval. These deficiencies are required to be rectified by the District. The District is proposing amendments to the rule to correct the deficiencies. Changes from the current rule include:

- Add to the definitions of PM10 and PM2.5 to clarify that both the solid and the condensable components are included.
- Delete the specified interpollutant offset ratios for PM2.5 and replace with the requirement that a modeling demonstration be made to justify any interpollutant offset ratios for PM2.5.
- Add a requirement for public notice for new lead emissions from a source that reaches five tons per year, or more.

On Thursday, August 8, 2013, at their regular meeting beginning at 2:30 PM, the Placer County Air Pollution Control District Board of Directors will hold a public hearing to receive comments and consider the adoption of the amended Rule 502, New Source Review. The hearing is to be held at the Placer County Board of Supervisors Chambers, 175 Fulweiler Avenue, Auburn, California.
