**NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOPS AND PUBLIC HEARINGS**

**PROPOSED NEW RULE 247, NATURAL GAS-FIRED WATER HEATERS,  
SMALL BOILERS, AND PROCESS HEATERS**

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF RULE 604, SOURCE TEST OBSERVATION  
AND REPORT EVALUATION**

Placer County Air Pollution Control District proposes to adopt new Rule 247 which will limit the sale and installation of new natural gas-fired water heaters, small boilers and process heaters in the range of 75,000 Btu/hr to 5 million Btu/hr to emissions of no more than 20 ppmv of NOx. This emission limit will be effective on January 1, 2015.

The District also proposes to amend Rule 604 to update the fees charged for observing source tests and reviewing source test reports. Fees for the observation of gas station testing and the review of gas station test reports are included.

A workshop on Rule 247 will be held on Thursday September 19, 2013, starting at 10:00 AM in the District offices located at 110 Maple Street, Auburn, CA.

A workshop on Rule 604 will be held on Thursday September 26, 2013, starting at 10:00 AM in the District offices located at 110 Maple Street, Auburn, CA.

On Thursday, October 10, 2013, at their regular meeting beginning at 2:30 PM, the Placer County Air Pollution Control District Board of Directors will hold public hearings to receive comments and consider the adoption of the these rules. The hearings are to be held at the Placer County Board of Supervisors Chambers, 175 Fulweiler Avenue, Auburn, California.
