NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF RULE 610
AIR TOXICS “HOT SPOTS” FEES**

Placer County Air Pollution Control District proposes to amend District Rule 610, Air Toxics “Hot Spots” Fees. This rule specifies the fees the District charges facilities to recover costs associated with the implementation of the Air Toxics “Hot Spots” Information and Assessment Act of 1987, beginning with Section 44300 of Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code. Amendments of the Rule include:

- Updating fees to cover District costs
- Charging the State fee separately from the District fee
- Providing for annual fee adjustments per the California Consumer Price Index
- Add stationary diesel engines as an industrywide category
- Revise penalties for non-payment of fees

On Thursday, October 9, 2014, at their regular meeting beginning at 2:30 PM, the Placer County Air Pollution Control District Board of Directors will hold a public hearing to receive comments and consider the adoption of the amended Rule 610, Air Toxics “Hot Spots” Fees. The hearing is to be held at the Placer County Board of Supervisors Chambers, 175 Fulweiler Avenue, Auburn, California.

By this notice, all interested parties are advised of the availability of the proposed rule amendment and are invited to comment on it.
