# WEST PLACER MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL

Wednesday, August 10, 2011

A regular meeting of the West Placer Municipal Advisory Council was held on Wednesday, August 10, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. at the Creekview Ranch Middle School, Roseville, Ca.

1. Call to Order:

2. Pledge of Allegiance: Led by Chairperson John Hottle

3. Roll Call: Council members present: John Hottle, Darryl Osborne, Walt Wylie, Carolyn Riolo

4. Approval of the Agenda. Darryl Osborne moved to approve the agenda as presented. Walt Wylie seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

At this time Carolyn Riolo entered for the meeting and was introduced to the public as the newest member of the MAC.

- 5. Approval of the Minutes of April 13, 2011. Walt Wylie moved to approve the minutes of April 13, 2011. Darryl Osborne seconded. Motion carried 4-0
- 6. Public Comment: Carolyn Flinn reported that the County roads Dept. was not servicing the median on Walerga not was the Parks Dept. working on the Doyle Ranch Park which has now become a fire hazard. There are also broken sprinklers. Diane asked that the County please ask Roseville City Road Dept. to notify residents when they are working on Baseline and please refrain from blocking off all entrances to the County side of Baseline.
- 7. Supervisor Report: Eric Goldman reported that the Board of Supervisors adopted the Dry Creek/West Placer Transportation Element on Aug. 9, 2011 making it a part of the Dry Creek/West Placer Community Plan. This is an important document as it creates a plan for circulation in the area for the next 30 years and supersedes the plan calling for the closure of PFE and potentially moves forward with a plan to remove the barrier at Cook Riolo and Baseline. The Board of Supervisors is also working on the budget, redistricting, realignment of the prison population and Supervisor Duran has asked for suspending the individual supervisors spending allotments in view of the tight budget arena. This item was suspended subject to conditions of disbursement being established.
- 8. Public Safety:

- A. County Sheriff's Department. Officer Bell reported again that the community is being hit with copper thefts. Lynn Harrison thanked the community for a very successful National Night Out event held on Aug. 2.....Doyle Ranch always has a very popular event.
- B. Cal-Fire: Chief Lopez reported that fire season has been slow and the disk line program has been quite successful in keeping fires down. He introduced Capt. Jim Hudson.
- C. CHP: Officer Mike Ketterer reported that he is back in the area and will be happy to check on speeds and racing in the area. With the start of school they have already brought traffic issues to the forefront of some peoples' attention.

#### 9. Action Items:

a) Recommendation to Planning Commission and Board of supervisors to Adopt the Dry Creek Greenway Regional Vision and Certify the final EIR (10 min) Presented by Christopher Schmidt (Planning Dept). To provide a continuous and coordinated system of preserved lands and habitat, with a connecting corridor of walking, equestrian, and bicycle trails, from the Sacramento border to Dry Creek's sources, and to the Folsom Lake State Recreation Area. Christopher Schmidt explained the Greenway Vision project and asked that the MAC recommend approval to the Board of supervisors. This is a long range project to connect trails along regional watershed areas in Placer County and Sacrament. This is about 52,000 acres and will be some on roadways but mainly on trails or walking paths. Walt Wylie moved to recommend that the Board of supervisors accept the goals and plans of the Dry Creek Greenway concept plan to include the proposed equestrian trails and recreational corridors in place in the Placer Vineyards project and to certify the accompanying EIR. Darryl seconded. Motion carried 4-0

- . a) Presentation on Placer Arts. Presented by Angela Tahti. . Angela introduced herself and gave an over of the Placer Arts Council (founded 1983) and the connection that they provide between the community and the arts that are available in Placer County. Currently they are called Placer Arts 360 and can be accessed on line to view the multiply events and opportunities for citizens.
