A regular meeting of the West Placer Municipal Advisory Council was held on Wednesday, March 12, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. at the Creekview Ranch Middle School, Roseville, Ca.

1. Call to Order: Walt Wyllie called the meeting was called to order at 7:00

2. Pledge of Allegiance: Walt Wyllie led the pledge.
3. Approval of the Agenda: Darryl Osborne moved and Alicia Butler seconded a motion to approve the agenda as provided. Motion carried 3-0.
4. Approval of the Minutes of February 19, 2014: Darryl Osborne moved to approve the minutes of February 19, 2014. Motion carried 3-0
5. Public comment: Any member of the public may address the Municipal Advisory Council on any matter that is NOT listed on the agenda. Comments will normally be limited to three (3) minutes per person at the discretion of the Chairperson. Gordon Gimbel wanted the MAC to know that persons had entered his property on Vineyard Rd by hopping the fence at around 11:30 pm Sunday evening and two weeks prior the neighbor across the street had a saw stolen during the night. The Sheriff officer present took note of the incidents.
6. Supervisor Report: Cristina Rivera reported that the Board of supervisors had approved the Costco property in Auburn 4-1 for development. She also informed the MAC that the City of Roseville is in early discussions on making Vernon St. (outside) a non-smoking area. The Foresthill Bridge improvement will have a grand opening on April 16, the Kings Beach project on April 21 and the regional sewer project had ground breaking today. She also spoke with Ken Grehm, DPW director and he will be looking into better markings and shaving down the speed humps on Cook Riolo. She also reported that the light issue at Morgan Greens (entrance light) was a HOA issue and they need to contact SMUD. .
7. . Public Safety:
 - A. County Sheriff's Department: Deputy Schmidt urged the neighborhood to lock their car doors at night, leave nothing in them, close garage doors, and use common safety measures to avoid the recent thefts in the area.
 - B. Cal-Fire : Fred Lopez reported very little happening except for dozens of bonfire related parties in the west area which are causing problems. The owner/developer is willing to help and will be posting the property which will allow for the ability to issue citations. Chuck Barsdale asked about the confusion on a recent medical call on Vineyard which has been fixed. .

A. Overview of the Affordable Care Act, presenter: Cheryl Davis, Director, Placer County Health and Human Services, will provide an overview of how provisions of the Federal Affordable Care Act might affect Placer County residents. Ms. Davis introduced herself and presented a short video prepared by the Kaiser Foundation which condensed the 2000 page Affordable Care Act into about 5 minutes. She then provided a handout as well as reviewed data and information on how this affects Placer County (indicating that our county is actual in very good shape for employment and medical resources).
