A. County Mitigation Funds Project Request from Placer County Parks Division – Hidden Falls Regional Park Parking Lot Expansion Project

The Placer County Parks Division is requesting the MAC's support for County Park Dedication Fees from Recreation Area #6 funding, Lincoln Recreation Area, in the amount of \$15,000 for a parking lot expansion project at Hidden Falls Regional Park. In October 2006, the easterly 220 acres of Hidden Falls Regional Park (HFRP) was opened to the public with a 55 space automobile parking lot and space for approximately 12 equestrian trailers. In May 2013, Placer County opened an additional 980 acres of the park, thereby increasing use of the park by many different types of users. The Parks Division plans to construct approximately 25 additional automobile parking spaces and to double the capacity of the equestrian staging area. In order to enlarge the equestrian area, it will be necessary to relocate the existing helistop. The uncommitted fund balance in Recreation Area #6 is \$26,033.
