6. Public Safety and School Reports:

A. Placer County Fire (530) 277-2317 –Battalion Chief Jim Mathias –

- Effective June 1, 2014 burning will be suspended.
- Burn permits are currently required
- Effective ways of preventing fires around your property is to mow in the morning hours, do not mow on windy days, use caution around rocks.
- Inspectors will be going out for inspection of defensible space. There should be a 100 feet of defensible space around your house.
- Keep driveways clear and wide enough for fire apparatus to enter your property.
- Ensure that your address is highly visible.

- Full staffing effective May 19, 2014. 300 more firefighters in Cal Fire statewide. 11 engines will be 4 man staffed in stead of 3 man
- They are adding a Tach 3 engine at the Casino.
- AMGEN Tour came through town with little issues.
- Big Wake Weekend will not be on the South side (Placer County) of Camp Far West Lake. It will be on the North side (Yuba County) side. It will be held the weekend of May 29, 2014 through June 1, 2014.

Placer County Sheriff Office is offering a free identity theft prevention class on Monday June 23, 2014 from 6 – 8 p.m. at the Auburn Justice Center

B) **Ada Barros gave an update on the Placer County Vector Control.**

Vector is any animal capable of transmitting causative agent of human diseases or capable of producing discomfort.

The mosquito life cycle is adulticide; larvacide, biological and source reduction.

Placer County Vector control is fully staffed. There are field techs sampling standing water for larvae. The action threshold is 1 larvae in 5 dips. Draining water is a good preventative and treatment measure.
