They are lining up funding to continue their efforts to educate the public on fire safety.

 - 1. Fireworks are prohibited in all areas of unincorporated Placer County.
 - 2. CSUS is offering classes at Sierra College this fall. They will offer five upper division courses at Sierra College's Rocklin campus in a growing partnership between the schools. Three of the classes are business school offerings and two are general education courses.
 - 3. This year's Placer County Fair theme is “There's no Place like Placer”. The County fair opens June 25th and runs through June 28th.
 - 4. The County has opened a temporary homeless shelter at the Dewitt Center in buildings 303 A&B. This will be an overnight facility and those wanting to stay overnight will have to be admitted between 5p.m and 8 pm. One of the main purposes of the shelter is to get homeless individuals the services they need to integrate back into society and get off the streets.
 - 5. The Board is reviewing plans for addressing the 2015/2016 budget challenges. The budget development plan would be:
 - Expand capacity at the county's new jail while increasing treatment and programming available to adult offenders.
 - Complete development of the proposed Placer County Conservation Plan.

Provide a fire service funding approach for Placer County Fire, despite contract cost increases of 21 percent over last year.

Allow the county to continue making progress on deferred facility, road and trail maintenance.

6. Conservation on tap as Board hears drought update from Placer County Water Agency. PCWA customers reduced water use by an average 25 percent with residential customers saving 18 percent and agricultural users saving 25%. PCWA is required to reduce consumption by 32 percent.
