- Keep clearance around house
- Have an escape plan
- When asked to evacuate, do so
- Donations, is best to donate to the Red Cross or local agencies. No need to bring food and water to the firefighters fighting the fires as they go out completely contained
- All 343 Cal Fire employees are on duty

Local activity:

- On 9/21/15 a 30 acre fire started in Nevada County near Camp Far West

- While testing the new sewer treatment plan pipeline the pipeline erupted in a gusher rising 4 to 5 feet into the air on Virginiatown Road.

- New Code Enforcement Officer Ted Real (530) 745-7542
 - Placer County Board of Supervisors has approved the first phase of Placer Parkway from Whitney Ranch / Highway 65 to Foothill Blvd. Once completed it will connect Highway 65 to Highway 99/70
 - Placer County is looking into a Slaughter facility for cut and wrap and are looking potentially in the Sheridan area.
 - The County approved bike lane project on a key stretch of Auburn Folsom Road at Douglas
 - The County held a forum to address the County’s rowing older and disabled population.
 - For the 13th consecutive year, Placer County’s Procurement Services Division has received the Achievement of Excellence in Procurement Award, one of the nation’s highest honors for responsible spending practices. The award is sponsored by the National Procurement Institute and a number of national and state partner associations. Placer County is one of only 49 government agencies in California and one of only 47 counties in the United States and Canada to receive an award this year.

Chief Jim Mathias was asking for the public and the MAC's recommendation what should or should not be done with the current Fruitvale/Fowler Fire Station 73 sign. The history of the sign is that an Eagle Scout constructed this sign and planter box in 1980. The choices are:

- Leave as is with some landscape
- Sand and refinish existing sign
- 2 sided sign
- 2 sided sign with changeable message board
- Any other ideas

The majority of input was to leave the sign as is with improvements.

The MAC's comments were:

Richard Lewis did not like the larger sign
Joyce Bachman liked the original sign

Richard Lewis made the following motion:

Move to keep the existing sign and base in place at the Fruitvale-Fowler Fire Station after refurbishing the sign, and explore the option of purchasing a portable message board for the station.

The MAC voted 4-0 to recommend the motion brought by Richard Lewis.

9. Informational - Non - Action Item:

Update on the development plan of Placer Vineyards

The project was originally approved by the Board of Supervisors in 2007. The project is located in southwestern Placer County and contains approximately 5,230 acres. Development includes a mixed-use planned community including 14,132 residential units, 274 acres of commercial uses, 919 acres of park and open space land, and 851 acres of quasi-public uses (i.e., public facilities/services, schools, roadways, religious facilities).
