- a. **Fire Service Funding - Presenter: Rui Cunha, Assistant Director, Emergency Services**

The Placer County Fire Department in the North Auburn Ophir Area anticipates that it will be \$350,000 in the red for the current fiscal year. In addition, should the economy continue the same trend for the next couple years, the expectation is that for the next fiscal year, it will be an additional \$550,000 in the red, exhausting its reserves. b. State Fire Fees - Presenter: Rui Cunha, Assistant Director, Emergency Services

The State of California has implemented a not to exceed \$150 fee on each structure on a parcel that is within a state responsibility area for fire prevention activities beginning July 1, 2011. Just recently, a new bill SB 1X 7, has just been introduced which will increase that fee even further for prevention and protection. The MAC will hear how this bill, if passed by the governor, will impact Placer County residents.
