**Regular Meeting**  
**May 28,2013**

**Minutes**

*Chairman Brodovsky called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. He led the Pledge of Allegiance.*

**DIRECTORS PRESENT:** Chairman Bob Brodovsky, Directors Mike Bishop, Anita Yoder and Patty Neifer. County Staff: Supervisor Jim Holmes and Administrative Aide Ruth Alves and Andy Fisher, Placer County Parks.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** After reviewing the posted agenda, *Director Bishop moved to approve the agenda as posted. Seconded by Director Neifer; motion carried unanimously.*

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES/March 26, 2013-**After reviewing the submitted minutes, *Director Neifer made the motion to approve the minutes as submitted; seconded by Director Bishop. Motion carried unanimously.*

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Local residents voiced their concerns on several issues in the Penryn area. They included: the generation of a "Priority Use" for Penryn improvements, Quarry issues (trails/parking lot/maintenance/suspicious vehicles), amount of signage at Taylor Rd and English Colony, Dead Palm trees...safety concerns, who's responsible?, and bicycle riders on English Colony...safety issues. General discussion followed.
