A. Emergency Shelter Zoning Text Amendment (ZTA)

Planning staff will provide an overview of the proposed Zoning Text Amendment, which will add Heavy Commercial (C3) and Industrial (IN and INP) zone districts to the land uses where an Emergency Shelter is an allowed use with a Use Permit. The proposed ZTA also includes revised standards for management practices and security requirements. The MAC is being asked to make a recommendation to the Planning Commission on the proposed ZTA.
