On Tuesday, August 5th, neighborhoods throughout Placer County are being invited to join forces with thousands of communities nationwide for the **"31st Annual National Night Out"** crime and drug prevention event. National Night Out, which is sponsored by the National Association of Town Watch, will involve over 16,000 communities from all 50 states, U.S. territories, Canadian cities and military bases worldwide. In all, over 37.8 million people participated in NNO 2013.

National Night Out is designed to:

- (1) Heighten crime and drug prevention awareness;
- (2) Generate support for, and participate in, local anti-crime efforts;
- (3) Strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships;
- (4) Send a message to criminals letting them know neighborhoods are organized and fighting back.

From 6 to 10 p.m. on August 5th, residents in neighborhoods throughout Placer County are asked to lock their doors, turn on outside lights and spend the evening outside with neighbors and members of the sheriff's office.

Many neighborhoods throughout Placer County will be hosting a variety of special events such as block parties, flashlight walks, contests, and youth activities, to:

"Give Neighborhood Crime and Drugs A Going Away Party"
and
"Say Goodbye to Crime"
