  - A. The Alpine Meadows / Squaw Valley Base to Base Gondola – the proposed project spans 13,000 linear feet from the Squaw Valley Ski Resort to the Alpine Meadows Ski Resort. The Squaw Valley terminal is located between the KT-22 and Squaw One Express Chairs, and the Alpine terminal is located between the Roundhouse Express and Hot Wheels Chairs. The project area crosses private lands either owned or leased by Squaw Valley Ski Holdings or the United States Forest Service (USFS), and is adjacent to, but does not cross into the Granite Chief Wilderness Area. The gondola is an eight person gondola with a capacity to carry 1,400 persons per hour in each direction. It is for winter operation only. Eight Gazex exploders near the Alpine Meadows mid-station are proposed for avalanche control. Approvals require certification of an Environmental Impact Report, a Conditional Use Permit and a General Plan Amendment to the Squaw Valley General Plan. Since a portion of the project on the Alpine Meadows side is on USFS property, the project requires an amendment to their existing Special Use permit and a separate Environmental Impact Statement - Heather Beckman, Associate Planner, Placer County Planning Services, Jim Spenst, Squaw-Alpine Project Manager and Adrienne Graham, Environmental & Planning Consultant
