### Hi Laura,

I did some quick calculations to find the VMT numbers for the existing conditions (Alt. 2). For summer, there are no regularly operating uses on the project site, therefore the VMT would be 0. For winter, the daily trip generation is 2,535 trips. We analyzed these trips as day skiers and the total VMT generation is 13,328. These numbers are for the project only and do not include the VMT for whole Tahoe Basin.

If you need background VMT projections (for the entire Lake Tahoe Basin) these can be found in the Regional Transportation Plan - Mobility 2030 of page 64.
