NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF A FINAL EIR FOR PUBLIC REVIEW

Notice is hereby given on November 9, 2012 that Placer County has prepared a Final Environmental Assessment/Environmental Impact Report (EA/EIR) for the following project. This item is now available for public review at the locations listed below. The Final EA/EIR together with the Draft EA/EIR must be considered by decision-makers before approving or denying the project. A public hearing is tentatively scheduled with the Board of Supervisors for November 20, 2012.

PROJECT NAME: Sewer Maintenance District 3 Regional Sewer Project (State Clearinghouse# 2011122079)

<u>PROJECT LOCATION</u>: The project area includes the Sewer Maintenance District (SMD) 3 (Horseshoe Bar area) wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) located at 4928 Auburn-Folsom Road (APN: 036-110-011-000) in the unincorporated area of Loomis and preferred alignment of the sewer force main that would extend south for approximately 4.5 miles to connect to the SMD 2 (Granite Bay area) collection system, and within the Auburn-Folsom Road and Joe Rodgers Road right-of-way (ROW).

<u>PROJECT DESCRIPTION</u>: Placer County's proposed SMD 3 Regional Sewer Project consists of decommissioning the SMD 3 WWTP and constructing a pump station and force main to convey wastewater from the existing WWTP to the SMD 2 collection system for treatment at the City of Roseville Dry Creek WWTP. The goal of the project is to bring the SMD 3 system into compliance with waste discharge requirements and a Cease and Desist Order issued by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board.

The Final EA/EIR consists of (1) Introduction, (2) Comments on the Draft EA/EIR, (3) Responses to Comments (4) Text Revision to the Draft EA/EIR, (5) List of Preparers, Final Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (Appendix A), and Consultation and Coordination (Appendix B).
