



Tahoe Biomass Facility Progress

- Placer County has secured a \$1,427,250 grant from Senator Feinstein/Congressman Doolittle
 - This will be used for "Down Payment on technology"
 - LOI from Sierra Pacific Power
 - DOE grant progressing
 - Air Emissions can be met
 - Economics look good
 - New site with greater potential in Kings Beach
 - Technology progressing/costs coming down
 - Pre-Development proposal in the works



On-Going Biomass Programs


- Community biomass collection

Air Pollution saved






















Regional Biomass Collection Project Results

- 2008 Regional Biomass removal Tahoe Basin
 - Biomass processed and transported (Loyalton and Carson City)
 - 330 BDT
 - Biomass chipped and used for ski slope stabilization

229 BDT



PM10 -- 7 tons, 97% CO -- 68 tons, 98% NOx - 1.5 tons, 74% VOC - 7 tons, 99%
