The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments on the Draft EIR/EIS for the project. Comments related to the project merits will be considered at a future hearing on the entitlements for the project.

The proposed Homewood Mountain Resort Ski Area Master Plan CEP Project is a mixed-use, redevelopment project that is being considered under the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's (TRPA) Community Enhancement Program (CEP). The CEP seeks "net gain solutions for the Lake Tahoe Basin which implement environmental improvements, enhance quality of life for residents, improve the visitor experience, and contribute to the long-term economic vitality of the Region." The focus of the

CEP is to encourage community revitalization and substantial environmental, as well as social and economic benefits, by providing incentives for mixed-use development projects on existing disturbed or underutilized sites.

This hearing falls between the 60-day public comment period for the Draft EIR/EIS began **January 21, 2011** and concludes on **March 21, 2011**. Comments will be solicited during this comment period and will be incorporated into the Final EIR/EIS document along with responses to comments.
