They did not provide me with a site plan, but the lights are replacements. They will be cemented in sub-grade, but will not increase coverage. The trenching is only for wiring upgrades and will be done with a ditchwitch (approximately .95 cubic yards) which will not result in the need for grading permit. The property is on the lakeside, but the buildings obscure most of the lighting as they are for the pathways in the parking lot and along the paths. For one or two lights that may be seen from the Lake or Roadway, there won't be any visible light

source.
