REPORT FROM THE PLANNING DIRECTOR - EJ Ivaldi, Deputy Planning Director, reported on the following:

Planning Commission scheduling. Next month's trip to Tahoe to tour the Squaw Valley Specific Plan and Martis Valley West Parcel project sites will occur at a later date as the Martis Valley site is too difficult to get to right now with the snow. The Final EIRs for both projects will be released sometime around the end of April.

March 10th Planning Commission meeting will be cancelled. March 24th meeting will be held in Auburn to hear the Medical Marijuana Ordinance introduction and possibly the Winding Creek Subdivision modification. April 14th hearing there is an item on today's hearing to be continued to that date and April 28th we will revisit the possibility of a Tahoe trip.

At the Board of Supervisors meeting on Tuesday they were updated on the status of the Placer County Conservation Plan.

Commissioner Nader asked what is the status and where it at this point?

EJ response: The purpose of the update was to focus on the funding/cost of the program. Several members from the State and Federal agencies were there to speak. The focus will now be on the EIR process. Gerry Haas response: They hope to have the final PCCP draft public document done within a month or two for release for the public to view and the draft EIR is hoped to be finished by spring.

DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT (PEIR20050277) – PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT 5 MONTGOMERY)

Conduct a public hearing to receive comments on the Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Auburn Creekside Center Project. The opportunity to discuss the merits of the project will occur at subsequent hearings on the project entitlements. The project proposes construction of a commercial retail center on a 13.2-acre parcel located east of State Route (SR) 49, immediately north of the Target store in North Auburn. The proposed development areas are situated on the east and west sides of a tributary to Rock Creek, which traverses the site from south to north. The development site is approximately 6.6 acres in area; the remaining 6.6 acres will be provided as right-of-way dedications (3.3 acres) and open space (3.3 acres). The development may be phased, ultimately consisting of up to 90,105 square feet of new retail space and parking for 326 vehicles. The project proposes extending Education Street east, bridging the creek, and terminating at a new traffic circle at Quartz Drive. Required entitlements for this project include a Conditional Use Permit, a Parcel Map to divide the parcel into four separate parcels, and a Design/Site Review Agreement.

A copy of the Draft EIR and Technical Appendices is available for review. The public comment period for the Draft EIR for the Auburn Creekside Center is from January 15, 2016 to February 29, 2016. Comments on the Draft Specific Plan can be submitted throughout the review of the project. A hard copy of the Draft EIR are available for review during normal business hours at the Community Development Resource Agency public counter located at 3091 County Center Drive in Auburn, at the County Clerk, and the Auburn Library, 350 Nevada St, Auburn, CA 95603. WILLOW PARK SUBDIVISION – GATED ENTRANCE CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT MODIFICATION (PLN15-00454/CUP-2747)

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT 1 (DURAN)

(APPLICANT IS REQUESTING A CONTINUANCE)

Consider a request from Michelle Engel on behalf of the Willow Park Homeowners Association, for approval of a Conditional Use Permit modification to allow for 1) an electronic vehicular gate at PFE Road and Canopy Tree Street that incorporates two pedestrian gates, and 2) to replace the current manual emergency vehicle access gate at Bulrush Street and Cook Riolo with a decorative wrought iron manual emergency access vehicular gate and one pedestrian gate. The project also proposes safety lighting for the gate areas. The subject property, which encompasses the roadway entrance area on Canopy Tree Street at PFE Road, and the Emergency Vehicle Access gate area on Bulrush Street at Cook Riolo Road for the Willow Park subdivision are currently zoned RS-AG-B-20 PD = 2 (Residential Single Family combining Agriculture combining a minimum building site size of 20,000 square feet and a Planned Development of 2 dwelling units per acre) and is located in the Dry Creek area. The Planning Commission will also consider a finding of a Categorical Exemption pursuant to Section 15303 of the CEQA Guidelines and Section 18.36.050(E) of the Placer County Environmental Review Ordinance Class 3 New Construction of Accessory Structures.
