RE: Department of the Interior's Payments in Lieu of Taxes (PILT) Program

Dear Senator Feinstein:

On behalf of the Placer County Board of Supervisors, I respectfully request your help and support in developing a funding solution for the Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILT) program. The current authorization for PILT expired on September 30, 2014 and without congressional action, the loss of funding will impact our ability to provide essential services to residents and visitors.


Placer County is one of nearly 1,900 counties in 49 states and three U.S. territories that receive PILT funding. The federal government owns approximately 41 percent of all land in Placer County, and these lands are not taxable. For Placer County, the loss is \$621,011 based on FY 2014 funding levels. PILT helps to offset these losses in tax revenues that are essential for funding services such as road and bridge maintenance, law enforcement, fire protection and emergency medical services.

Currently the House Interior, Environment and Related Agencies subcommittee appropriations bill includes \$442 million for PILT as a one-year extension of mandatory spending. However, the Senate has no comparable measure. I urge you to work with your colleagues and leadership to ensure that we can continue to provide services necessary to keep our nation's counties healthy, vibrant, safe and resilient.
