PLACER COUNTY SEXUAL ASSAULT RESPONSE TEAM (S.A.R.T.)

Applications are being accepted for Sexual Assault Forensic Examiners (SAFEs). This is an Independent Contractor position. The SAFE is responsible for conducting the medical-forensic sexual assault evidentiary examinations. The SAFE will medically assess the victim or suspect (male or female), collect forensic evidence, document injuries or findings, take forensic photos, provide medications to prevent pregnancy and sexually transmitted diseases, maintain the chain of custody, and provide fact or expert testimony in a court of law. Exams are conducted at Sutter Roseville Medical Center or Sutter Auburn Faith Hospital.

Requirements:

- Current CA licensure as a Registered Nurse, Nurse Practitioner, Physician's Assistant, or MD.
- At least one year acute care experience, preferably in Emergency/Trauma, Critical Care, or Women's Health.
- Strong verbal communication and critical thinking skills.
- Attend an approved SAFE training course.
- Criminal background investigation screening prior to employment.
- Meet clinical competencies during S.A.R.T. orientation.
- Take flexible call hours: minimum 5 shifts during the week/month and one weekend/month rotation.
- Attend monthly meetings, which include case and photo review.
- Valid CA driver's license.
