How to Use Your 14 Day and 30 Day Passes

- 14 Day and 30 Day Passes need to be swiped through the farebox each time you board the bus.
- The **FIRST TIME YOU USE** one of these passes, "**DIP**" your pass in the farebox card slot, located at the top left of the farebox. This will start the activation date. (Figure 3 below.)
- For all following trips, "SWIPE" your pass through the diagonal slot located at the top right of the farebox with the magnetic stripe facing you. (Figure 3 below.)
- A BEEP will sound alerting that the pass has been accepted.





Where to Purchase Your Pass

- PLACER COUNTY TRANSIT office in Auburn, located at 11432 F Ave. (Behind the Road Department).
- Directly from the driver when boarding the bus. PLEASE BE SURE TO LET THE DRIVER KNOW YOU WANT TO BUY A PASS <u>BEFORE</u> INSERTING CASH INTO THE FAREBOX.

How to Care for Your Pass

- Do not get it wet.
- Do not expose it to the sun.
- Do not wrinkle, fold or tear it.
- Do not write on it.
- Damaged or destroyed cards will not be replaced or refunded.



Effective Monday, January 17, 2011, Placer County Transit (PCT) will introduce new economical passes for frequent riders - a **10 RIDE PASS**, **14 DAY PASS** and a **30 DAY PASS**. Ticket books will no longer be sold. 10 ride ticket books will be replaced with a **10 RIDE PASS**, 20 ride ticket

books will be replaced with a 14 DAY UNLIMITED

RIDE PASS, and 40 ride ticket books will be replaced with a 30 DAY UNLIMITED RIDE PASS. Old tickets will continue to be accepted. 10 RIDE PASSES will replace the 10 ride ticket books. To use a 10 RIDE PASS, insert or "DIP" the pass in the farebox card slot when



boarding the bus. (Photo 1 above.) The number of remaining rides will print on the back of the pass. (Figure 1 above.)

How Much do Passes Cost?

Type of Pass	General Public	Senior/Youth/Disabled
10 RIDE PASS	\$10.00	\$5.00
14 DAY PASS	\$21.50	\$10.75
30 DAY PASS	\$37.50	\$18.75



A 14 DAY PASS is good for unlimited rides for 14 days from the date of first use. A 30 DAY PASS is good for unlimited rides for 30 days from the date of first use. 14 DAY and 30 DAY PASSES can be purchased today and not used for the first time until later. To use a 14 or 30 DAY PASS the first time, insert or "DIP" the pass into the farebox card slot. (Photo 1 left.) This first use activates the pass. The first day the pass was used and the date and time it will expire will print on the back of the pass. (Figure 2 above.) For all following trips, "SWIPE" the pass through the diagonal slot, with the magnetic stripe facing you, when boarding the bus. (Photo 2 below).

How Can Passes Save Me Money?

If you ride the bus to and from work or school every weekday in a month, a general public 24-HOUR PASS (\$2.50/day for 20 days) would cost you about \$50 a month. If you purchase a **30 DAY PASS**, you will save about \$12.50 a month.
