Foresthill Hall Board Minutes: Sept 12, 2011

1. Meeting called to order @ 6:07PM

2. Pledge of Allegiance

3. Roll Call- Present: Seat #1 Rich Murray; Seat #2 Vince Robinson; Seat #3 Steve Stevenson; Seat #4 Steve Cannizzarro; Seat #6 Vicki Haskins Campbell; Seat #7 Supervisor Montgomery

Absent: Seat # 5 VACANT; Vickey Price w/American Legion Aux present to fill seat; submits application Placer Co Facility Svs: Cathy Harley, Dennis Hughes

Secretary notes all seats expired 8/31/11; Dennis reports appointments on Board of Sups meeting agenda upcoming.

4. Approval of Minutes: NO Corrections; Approved.

5. Public Comment: Laura Nelson / Foresthill Chamber of Commerce spoke to an unfavorable incident she experienced with reserving the BBQ area only; hall custodian could not make the reservation as the database was not available so referred to Auburn Parks Dept who also could not make an immediate reservation so promised callback to Chamber; after a week Laura contacted Auburn again and then was asked to provide a \$250 deposit although the Chamber already has a \$250 deposit on hand with Placer Co; further delay in response so Laura had to drive to Auburn to provide a deposit check and complete reservation which noted the return of deposit in 4-6 weeks after use; lodged complaint in process/experience with BBQ reservation; deposit check has been returned after use of BBQ. Dennis explained that the database interface was in process at that time and apologized for the inconvenience; will follow-up with John @Parks Dept for clarification on the additional deposit request.

Foresthill Veterans Memorial Hall Operation Costs FY 2010/2011 (Attachment A: Foresthill Memorial Hall Operating Costs VS Revenue): Chair Stevenson reads the entire report to board; Custodial line-item is greatest cost (\$77,436.23) followed by Utilities (\$21,078.35), followed by Maintenance (\$16,314.98) followed by Grounds (\$4,447.66) followed by Admin Services ie Board Mtgs, Budgets, etc (2,034.75). Total costs \$121,311.97 vs Total revenue \$ 3,650.00 = <\$117,661.97> Negative cash flow; Supervisor Montgomery speaks to the imbalance and the importance of considering who qualifies for fee waiver when renting the hall; shepherding public funds and the use of county buildings is critical; reference to Attachment C: Consideration of Fee Waiver/Reduction Requests in accordance with Placer County Code Chapter 2 Section 2.82.120.

Subject: Clarification of Placer County Code Chapter 2 Section 2.82.120 - Payment for Use of Memorial Halls

Dear Hall Board Trustees,

It has come to the attention of the Department of Facility Services that clarification of Placer County Code Chapter 2 Section 2.82.120 - Payment for Use of Memorial Halls, would be valuable to you as you consider requests for fee waivers for use of your Memorial Hall.

As you are aware per Placer County Code Chapter 2 Section 2.82.120, payment for use of Memorial Halls is governed by the following provisions:

- A. Free use of the Halls shall be accorded to county veterans groups.
- B. As authorized by the Hall Board in accordance with scheduling and use submittal requirements, free use of the Halls shall be accorded to:
 - 1) county departments for non-routine county business
 - 2) nonprofit senior citizen groups
 - 3) nonprofit children activities groups (such as 4H or Scouts)
 - 4) community service clubs
- C. As granted by the Hall Board, reduced rates up to, but not exceeding fifty percent (50%) of the designated rental fee may be granted to:
 - 1) other community based nonprofit groups from the community in which the Veterans Hall is located.
- D. In all other instances, full payment of the designated rental fee shall be required.

The Department provides the following guidance as you consider these requests:

"Veterans groups" - duly recognized chartered organizations composed solely of honorably discharged members of the United States uniformed military services.

Administration - Building Maintenance - Capital Improvements - Museums - Parks
Property Management - Environmental Engineering - Utilities

"County departments for non-routine county business" may include advisory committees to the County and other governmental agencies using the Hall for governmental purposes (e.g., U.S. Forest Service, Municipal Advisory Councils, Historical Society, etc.)

The term "nonprofit" may include organizations who are formally recognized by the United State Internal Revenue Code as a tax-exempt, nonprofit corporation or association (e.g., 501(c)(3)) or not-for-profit organizations whose earnings are utilized to achieve charitable, religious, educational, scientific, literary, testing for public safety, fostering national or international amateur sports competition, preventing cruelty to children or animals, or other public purposes.

"Senior citizen groups" - organizations or groups that support and whose membership consists of individuals 60 years or older. For the purpose of interpreting this County Code, to qualify for a fee waiver, the senior citizen group must also be nonprofit.

"Children activities group" - organizations whose membership is for children only. For the purpose of interpreting this County Code, to qualify for a fee waiver, the children activities group must also be nonprofit.

"Community Service Clubs" – volunteer organizations comprised of community members who have a recognized public or charitable purpose and whose funds go to such causes (e.g. Lions Clubs International, Kiwanis Club, Soroptimist International).

"Other community based nonprofit groups from the community" – organizations from the community in which the Hall is located which have a recognized public or charitable purpose and whose funds go to such cause.

I hope this information is helpful in interpreting the County Code as you consider the fee waiver request for use of your Hall.

Foresthill Divide Memorial Chapel's Annual Easter Breakfast

The Foresthill Divide Memorial Chapel Board will hold its annual Pancake Breakfast on Easter Sunday, April 24, 2011, at the Veteran's Memorial Hall in Foresthill's LeRoy Botts Memorial Park.

In addition to pancakes, the breakfast menu will include ham and eggs, juice, coffee, and milk. Breakfast will be served beginning at 7:00 a.m. and will continue until 11:30 a.m. There is no set price for the breakfast; however, a donation of \$5.00 will be greatly appreciated per person. Any amount you can afford will be gratefully accepted.

This is the only fund raiser held by the chapel board. The proceeds will help maintain the chapel. The Foresthill Divide Memorial Chapel belongs to the people of Foresthill. It is available for weddings, funerals, church services, and special meetings. If you would like to make use of this wonderful building, please contact one of the Board of Directors: Frank Bendrick, Steve Cannizzaro, Steve Coffman, Rich Murray, Gene Orr, Walt Reed, or Ron Roussey.

In the late 1940s, Foresthill was a town of approximately 400 people where almost all social events were held at the community hall. This hall had been built with volunteer labor and was used for dances, movies, a skating rink, school graduations, local drama productions, birthday parties, church functions, and miscellaneous other functions which required spacious accommodations. There was one church in the town, the historic Catholic Church which was built during the gold rush, but other church functions were held at the community hall. The community hall provided a warm welcome for all functions.

Fund raising drives were held to build a chapel to house all denominations; however, these drives took on a new meaning during a funeral for a truck driver's young son who had died tragically from an accident in the woods. During this solemn service, a young boy from the local grammar school decided to attend the function knowing that, if it was being held in the community hall, it was a community event and it was normally fun. Unaware that it was a funeral service, the boy entered the services with his dog and proceeded to the front row and sat down to watch the festivities with the expectation that he would be entertained. At this time, the major employer was the Hughes Brothers Lumber Company, and, normally, when they got behind a project, its success was insured. As it turned out, Louise Shelton Hughes was in the funeral crowd and, upon seeing the disruption of the solemn service, she turned to her husband, Dave Hughes, and exclaimed "Dave, we are going to build a church in this town to be used for all denominations --- there must be a place for worship outside this hall used to accommodate all of the other social functions of the town."

In September, 1946, at a town meeting held at the Foresthill Community Hall, a Board of Directors for the Foresthill Divide Memorial Chapel was elected. Those elected to serve were: S. L. Hancock, local electrical contractor, L. L. Anderson, lumberman, and Louise Shelton Hughes, wife of David C. Hughes. It was the duty of these three people to work on plans, ways and means for a sacred building for use by all faiths and denominations.

The organization was incorporated on January 20, 1947. A ninety-nine year lease on the location of the present Chapel was secured from the Warren McKeon Post of the American Legion on March 3, 1948, and funds began to accumulate so construction could begin. The legal work was done by John Couzens of the firm Lowell and Lowell.

For a time, the Board attempted to locate a surplus chapel from a nearby army post. This did not prove successful. So, at last, it was decided that the building would be constructed from the ground up. Local lumber firms were contacted and asked for donations of lumber. All the lumber was given by local firms. The first construction was under the direction of S. L. Hancock begun in the summer of 1949. However, Mr. Hancock moved from Foresthill and the bulk of the construction was done by and under the supervision of Jay Wallen, a paid carpenter.

Many of the furnishings of the chapel were gifts. Much of the building materials were donated. Cash was given and benefits were held to raise more funds. The Hughes Brothers Lumber Company financed the project when funds were depleted and the carpenter continued to work.

During the fifty plus years since the Foresthill Divide Memorial Chapel was built, many denominations have used this quaint structure and all were welcomed. In the early 1950s, the Catholic Church burned down and they started using the memorial chapel to hold their services. Several denominations started out using the chapel and grew to the point where they became large enough to build their own church. The spiritual needs of the community have been well served by this edifice.

The Foresthill Divide Memorial Chapel Board of Directors, composed of willing volunteers, was established to schedule and maintain the structure. For over fifty years, this Board scheduled the various denominations, paid for or performed maintenance, and organized the annual fund raiser, and handled donations to keep the chapel going. For most of this time, George C. Grant headed the Board, Louise Hughes (Korges) was the first secretary and Jan Nelson carried on for many years after Louise left. Some of the long-time helpers were: Jack Knuckey, Ted Nelson, Jan Nelson, Joyce Thoma, and Merv Hinkley. The one and only fund raiser has been the Easter breakfast where donations were accepted for the breakfast. With careful management of these donations, the chapel has been maintained over the years. In 1998, George Grant started

getting sick and, knowing that he lacked the energy to continue to serve in the manner that was required, he hand-picked his successor – Frank Nafziger. George died of lung cancer in early 1999, and the family requested that, in lieu of flowers, donations be given to the chapel for a major refurbishment. In tribute to George, over \$25,000 was collected.

On August 6, 1999, the original time capsule was opened in a ceremony recognizing the major improvements. A letter describing recent history of the chapel was included in the new time capsule along with a Foresthill telephone directory. Since the original time capsule was created, the logging industry has left Foresthill. We have become a bedroom community of about 5,600. Tourism is beginning to become a factor in the economy of the town. Our Foresthill Divide Memorial Chapel is highly-sought after as a picturesque setting for small weddings. Foresthill is currently becoming a town where people come to get married away from the big cities.

So, to all of you people of the Foresthill Divide from a bunch of us that lived in the 1900s, we request that you use and take care of this little chapel that we built and preserved for you.
