## What should not be in your garbage? Household Hazardous Wastes (HHW)



- fluorescent tubes
- small household batteries
- vehicle (lead acid) batteries
- used oil filters
- used motor oil
- compressed gas cylinders less than 5 gallons (i.e. camping-sized)
- latex paint
- sharps (syringes & lancets)
- automotive fluids
- compressed gas cylinders less than 20lbs. (i.e. bbq-sized)
- contaminated oil
- household cleaners
- mercury-containing devices (thermometers & thermostats)
- paint & paint products
- paint - oil-based
- pesticides & herbicides
- pool chemicals
- medications
- most products labeled DANGER, CAUTION, WARNING, FLAMMABLE, or POISON
- small aerosol cans
- solvent / degreasers
- varnish & shellac

### Electronic Waste (E-Waste)

- answering machines
- calculators
- computers & computer peripherals
- televisions & computer monitors
- radios
- stereo equipment
- telephones & cell phones
- video recording equipment
