

Save Our Water

Great job Sheridan!

Last year we asked you to cut back on your water use, based on the State's requirements prohibiting several outdoor watering activities, and you did - by 10%!

The State has revised and readopted requirements for 2015 and is requiring a 25% reduction in water use!

The State Water Board requires the following:

- Don't water lawns and outdoor plants more than two days per week.
- Don't water during or within 48 hours of rainfall.
- Don't water landscapes in a way that causes runoff.
- Don't wash hard surfaces, such as driveways and sidewalks.
- Don't wash your car with a hose that doesn't have a shut-off nozzle.
- Don't use water features and fountains without a recirculating system.

Your voluntary compliance with the above measures will help us meet the 25% goal and reduce the likelihood that the State will require additional conservation measures, such as individual water meters or other requirements, which would result in additional cost to you the rate payer.
