Public Recreation Ordinance – receive a report on existing use policies in the Public Recreation Ordinance and emerging topics including regulation of e-bikes, public operation of drones in public recreation areas and public use of Hidden Falls Regional Park during high wildfire risk. Recommend staff continue research of policy options and return to the Parks Commission with recommended policy changes for consideration.
 2. Dry Creek Area Projects – Playground Shade Structures, par course, and trail connection – recommend approval of \$468,960 in Area #13 Park Dedication Fees for the construction of shade structures over playgrounds at Dry Creek
