7. Information/Non-Action Item(s):

A. Proposed AT&T Cell Tower Project.

The MAC will receive an overview of a proposed wireless communications facility, including a 180-foot-tall tower to be located in the center of the project parcel, and a 100-foot by 100-foot master lease area on a 0.22-acre parcel located approximately 1,000 feet north of the intersection of Sunset Drive and Foresthill Road in Foresthill. The project lease area would include a pre-fabricated concrete equipment shelter measuring 8 feet by 8 feet located at the base of the tower. The proposed project would require approval of a Minor Use Permit.

B. Proposed Rural Recreation Resort

The MAC will receive an overview of Getaway House, a proposed rural recreation resort with approximately 60 tiny cabins for short-term, nightly rentals. The project site is comprised of seven separate parcels totaling 308 acres located on the north side of Foresthill Road between Melody Lane and Idelwild Road. The proposed project would require approval of a Minor Use Permit.
