

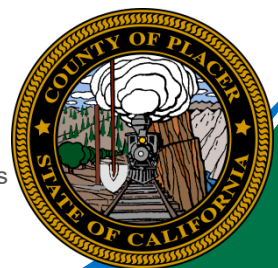

9. Information Items:

A. Guard Rail Replacement Ridge Road & Indian Hill Road (District 5)

Staff will present an overview of an upcoming public safety enhancement project which proposes to upgrade existing substandard roadway guardrail at three locations within the County, along portions of Indian Hill Road, Ridge Road, and Rollins Lake Road. This project is funded by the State Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). Within the boundaries of the Newcastle/Ophir MAC (Indian Hill Rd and Ridge Rd), a total of 6,180 linear feet of existing substandard guardrail will be removed and replaced. The new guardrail will meet current design standards to increase safety for the public traveling along these County Roads
