A. PG&E Community Wildfire Safety Program Update

PG&E will provide an update on a range of actions and initiatives being undertaken to reduce wildfire risk and increase the resiliency of the electric system.

B. Alternative Waste Collection at Foresthill Transfer Station (FTS) During Temporary Closure Related to FTS Tipping Wall Repairs Project – UPDATE

County staff will present an overview of the project and provide updated information on alternative waste collection services during an anticipated two-week closure period. Improvements include new AC pavement to improve conveying of surface water at the top of tipping wall, reconstructing the existing flowline, installing dikes, collection pipes and a rock filled gabion basket retaining wall. All flows will be directed towards the existing onsite treatment facility. The proposed drainage improvements will provide stability to the existing slope and reduce erosion at the site.
