The Madena 4 Solar Energy Storage proposes to construct a five-megawatt alternating current system that would include a Battery Energy Storage System and Solar Photovoltaic generation system on approximately 1.9 acres of land located at 5095 Commercial Place in Sheridan. The project site is zoned IN-AG-Dc (Industrial, combining Agriculture, combining Design Scenic Corridor). The purpose of the project is to generate clean, renewable, electrical power as well as reduce the impact of potential future Public Safety Power Shutoffs. The electricity generated from the site would be sold to an electric utility purchaser.
