

2019: BUILDING ON PROGRESS

- Improved financial outlook and position with newly created cash reserve and CalPERS/PARS contribution
- Successful implementation of the Carl Moyer Program, including other incentives
- Continued focus on biomass and forest resiliency
- Coordinated regional response with local health officials and schools during wildfire PM events
- PSPS coordination
- Local land use planning support
- Engagement in local, State and federal policy development and organizations

- Update forest resiliency and biomass policies
- Continue to implement and grow District's incentive program
- Engage on implementation of the State's Community Air Protection Program (AB 617)
- Develop effective policy on PSPS events

ALEXA BURN DAY LAUNCH

- Designed to provide another avenue for public outreach for burn day status
- Launched in February
 - Provides region specific burn day information
- Information can be requested on the following items
 - What is allowed to be burned
 - Non-residential burning
 - Chipping vegetative wood-waste
 - Composting
 - Fire safety
 - How a burn day is determined
 - How to file a smoke complaint
 - District contact information



INCENTIVE PROGRAM UPDATE

- ~ \$2M in total expected to be available
- Solicitation period planned April 1-May 31
 - Moyer and AB923 funds to be available
 - Selections to be determined in late summer
- AB617 workshop planned for March in Roseville
 - Intended to be BEFORE CAG solicitation
- FARMER program ongoing
 - Reporting tool development is beginning
 - Any Placer ag project will be directed to CAG



FISCAL UPDATE

- District remains on budget
 - Expenditures are below budget
 - Revenues trending higher
