

WHEREAS, Kirk Uhler first began his distinguished service as Placer County's District 4 Supervisor in 1993, at the age of 25, becoming the second youngest supervisor in California history; he served from 1993 to 1996, then returned to serve from 2007 through 2020, for a total of eighteen years of service; and

WHEREAS, Kirk has served on the Placer County Air Pollution Control District Board of Directors for 9 years as a primary Board member, and 9 years as an alternate; and

WHEREAS, Kirk has the rare distinction of participation on the District Board in 1993 when this Board was still convened solely by the County Board of Supervisors; and during the District Board's significant restructure in 1994, when its composition was altered to include both city council and County supervisor representatives; and

WHEREAS, Kirk has been a Placer County resident since 1970, and is a vehement supporter of the community; he has served on numerous local boards and commissions, including the Placer County Transportation Planning Agency; and he is an Eagle Scout from Granite Bay Troop 121.

WHEREAS, Kirk is a graduate of the University of California at Berkeley; served as the Chief Operating Officer of the Electric and Gas Industries Association; and was a founding employee of CarsDirect.com and Solar Power, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Kirk has worked for many years with steadfast resolve on vital County concerns, such as working with fellow supervisors to strengthen and maintain the County's long-term financial viability; developing the Placer County Conservation Plan; and focusing on affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, Kirk's lengthy presence on the District Board has provided a continuity crucial to meeting the air pollution challenges facing our community and region; and

WHEREAS, Kirk has enhanced our Board with his competence and straightforward nature (he says he has no poker face).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Placer County Air Pollution Control District Board of Directors, District staff, and the Placer County community that breathes cleaner air, express our sincere appreciation to Kirk Uhler for his dedicated service, and wish him all the best in his future endeavors.
