7. Information Item:

A. Proposed Reorganization of CSA 28, Zone 6A – Sheridan Sewer and Zone 23 – Blue Canyon (Robin Mahoney)

There is a proposal to merge Sheridan and Blue Canyon Sewer Services into one. The merger would create benefits for both areas. It would stabilize rates and there would be one budget instead of 2 to manage. Sewer rates would either remain the same or may be even lower. The proposed merger would be coming before the Board of Supervisors in the coming months.

B. Neighborhood Watch Program (Carly Redlick)

A neighborhood watch program would address immediate crime problems. Neighborhood watch groups are neighbors who look out for each other's families and property, alert law enforcement to any suspicious activities or crime in progress, and work together to make their community a safer and better place to live.

Basics are:

Select Coordinator: Identified and/or coordinate a main person of contact.

Communication: Have organized way to communicate within your neighborhood.

Call: If you see something suspicious or doesn't seem right, call the non-emergency dispatch – 530-886-5375. It is always best to call from a landline if one is available.

Do not approach: Do not contact suspicious person or vehicle. You never know what or who you will be dealing with.

Witness: Be a good witness; get as many details as possible such as vehicle make, model, color, license, window tint, stickers, damage, etc. For individuals – height, weight, skin color, hair, tattoos, etc.
