6	988 Mental Health National Hotline <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Geoff McLennan shared that there is new legislation coming forward that has been driven by the cell phone carriers. It is AB988, and it covers a dispatcher referring a call to a warm line in our county. Mr. McLennan believes that we may need to be prepared and asks if the pilot crisis center be able to filter these calls. Amy Ellis believes that there is more to come on this legislation as there are many questions coming at the statewide level. How this legislation rolls out in California is yet to be determined.
7	Youth and Fentanyl Danger <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 3 years ago, when Geoff served on the AOD committee, the committee was hearing that the fentanyl was coming into the country in various illegal ports of entry. Also, there are a number of mothers and families in Rocklin that are upset due to a recent fentanyl overdose of a 17-year-old. As parents, we do not want high school kids experimenting with these things. Geoff asked if there

	<p>should be an item presented.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ms. Ellis explained that this may be the next big topic to focus on. Currently, Nevada County has an increase in their numbers that is much higher than Placer County. Placer County's numbers are going up, but not as quickly as Nevada County. It is important to watch Nevada County to learn from them and engage the practices that work best. • Mr. McLennan asks that the sheriff be reminded about addressing this issue. Ms. Ellis shared that the Sheriff's Office was a big proponent of the naloxone campaign and this issue.
