1. **Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance:** Chairperson Walt Wyllie called the meeting to order at 6:35 and as led the pledge of allegiance.
2. **Welcome, Roll Call of MAC Members & Introductions as necessary:** Walt welcomed the community and the members introduced themselves. Present were Walt Wyllie, Patrick Shiehr, Mike Viale, and Debby McSherry. Absent was Jean Pagone. Supervisor Gore, Landon Wolf and Diane Howe were also present.
3. **Approval of June 9, 2021 agenda**
4. **Approval of March 10, 2021 and March 16, 2021 minutes:** The MAC took items 3 and 3 together. Patrick moved to approve the agenda for June 9 and the minutes from March 10 and March 16, 2021 as presented. Mike seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
5. **Public Comment:** Let us hear from you! Do you wish to share something that's NOT already on this agenda? We welcome your input at this time and kindly ask that you keep your comments to 3 minutes or less (or as determined by the chairman). Diane thanked the MAC members for their intense participation in the two March meetings on Zoom. They were complimented on listening, asking questions and supporting the residents affected by the proposed project on those agendas as well as the community plan. Other community members were concerned about the application of for construction of 79 homes on the current Morgan Creek golf course. Supervisor Bonnie Gore responded to questions on the development proposal indicating there will be 5 public meetings (per law) and potentially an EIR. Currently the planner to contact related to this project is Alex Fisch in county planning. There were questions about the status of the previously approved 7 homes in the Morgan Creek Development where only 3 have been built. Landon and Bonnie will look into this. Debby McSherry stated she believed those lots had been purchased from the golf course, built the 3 and seems to have lost interest.
6. **Reports:**
 - A. **Local Government:**

The MAC is composed of appointed community members whose purpose is to advise the Board of Supervisors about activities and problems of the area represented. 1. District 1 Supervisor: Bonnie reported that the County will be working on redistricting related to the recent census. The County would like residents to provide input and they envision trying to keep like areas in the same district.
 - a. Countywide Update: The Board has approved a new micro-trans project which will use a bus to and from Tahoe beginning on June 25. This will be free. The Board will be having a summit to address housing and homeless issue which are increasing in the County.
 - b. District 1 Update: Bonnie indicated that there is less development movement in the Placer Vineyards Specific Plan which will slow the Baseline improvements so the Board will be looking at a possible solution to move Baseline Rd. traffic more effectively. A community member asked about the slow internet speed with Consolidated. Landon reminded the group that there are no fireworks allowed in unincorporated Placer County and that Bonnie had authorized signs on street corners to remind people as well as Diane sending out her annual reminder.

7. Informational Items:

- A. Presentation by Placer Mosquito Vector Control District: Meagan Lucvano, Public Information Officer for the Mosquito Vector Control District gave an overview to the organization (22 staff, 4 seasonal staff, 7 member Board, and 13 drones with camera.) They service all of Placer County for invasive mosquitos and yellow jackets. Any chemical applications necessary are EPA approved and she urged people to use EPA tested sprays as they do fine disease in the vectors.

8. Action Items:

- A. Consideration of change of MAC meeting day from the second Wednesday to the third Wednesday of each month. As discussed in the March, 2020 meeting the meeting is being requested to move to the third Wed. rather than the current second Weds. Patrick moved to approve the change of meeting to the third Wednesday of each month as needed. Debby seconded. Motion carried 4-0. Diane and Landon will inform the MAC on a July meeting. Diane will e-mail the dates for the year related to this change.
