
In accordance with Section 2279 of the California Food and Agriculture Code, I hereby submit the Placer County Annual Crop Report for 1987.

The cattle industry was the leading industry in the County followed by the turkey and nursery industries.

This report reflects the gross value of the agricultural production in the County and does not reflect a net return to growers. Gross agricultural production in 1987 was \$51,080,500 with the timber industry bringing in an additional \$10,040,000 for a total value of \$61,120,500.

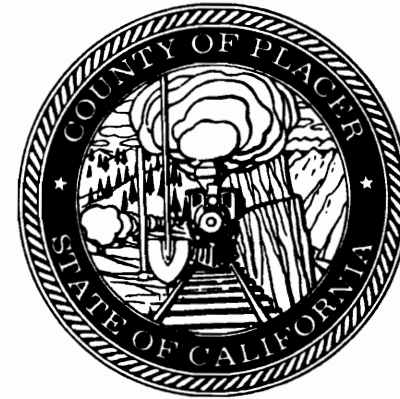
